

COVID-19 Vaccination Policy

Participants in any Beyond Our Boundaries trip will be required to provide documented proof of the participant's full vaccination (a one- or two-shot vaccine regimen, plus booster if eligible) administered at least 14 days prior to their trip.

We will also require all travelers to take an at-home COVID-19 test within 72 hours prior to departure of each trip and provide the Beyond Our Boundaries RN with proof of negative result.

We've decided this based upon serious consideration for the health and well-being of our travelers, staff, and volunteers and this decision was not made lightly.
